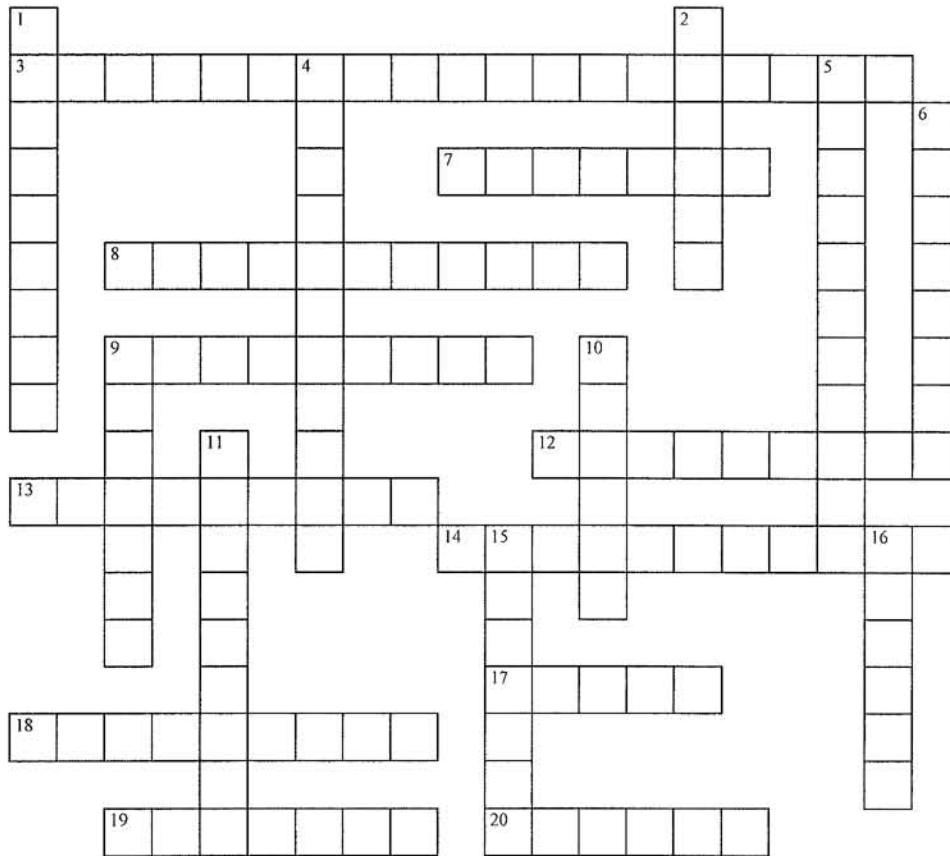


Lighthouses

- 12 Type of foundation used for offshore lighthouses (popular on Chesapeake Bay).
- 13 Person who came to look over a light station to see if it was being run properly.
- 14 Person who delivered gifts to light stations at Christmas.
- 17 Gold-colored metal in constant need of polishing.
- 18 Floating lighthouse.
- 19 Poisonous chemical used to support heavy lenses.
- 20 Person who tended a lighthouse.

- 1 System of weights and gears used to turn lenses.
- 2 Name of world's first known lighthouse.
- 4 Two lighthouses positioned near each other to guide ships into harbor.
- 5 Light station where families were not permitted to live.
- 6 Type of oil used in old-fashioned lamps.
- 9 Inventor of special lens used to magnify light from lighthouses.
- 10 Nickname for lighthouse keeper.
- 11 Shiny surface used to increase brightness of light.
- 15 Journal where keepers recorded weather, news.
- 16 Boat that brought supplies to keepers.
